Meat Cooking Schedule 6 am - 3 pm

6 am each day: Build fires and get meat ready to place on cookers.

11 am each day: Chop and season meat
After lunch: Meat to be packaged for sale.

2 pm daily: Clean up equipment

Brunswick Stew Set Up

Saturday, October 22:

After slaw has been completed, stew lines and pots will be set up. Come after lunch as there will be plenty to do.

Sunday, October 23: starting at 2 pm

The Youth will be washing buckets and getting the stew house ready. Another great opportunity for the whole family.

Brunswick Stew Cook Schedule

Early Monday, October 24 2 am - Until 3 pm

At 2 am begin cooking the meats for brunswick stew. At 5 am grind and portion out for rounds of stew for the following day and BBQ day. This will take all day so come when you can.



Early Tuesday, October 25 6 am - Until 3 pm

At 6 am start first round to be ready by 8 am. This will continue throughout the day until mid afternoon. Come stay the whole day or work a morning or afternoon shift. Starting at 8 am individual containers packaged for sale. Will need help stirring the stew pots all day long.

October 19, 20 & 24, 25

Please prepare a covered dish for Thursday, Friday, Monday or Tuesday for the workers. They are working hard and will be hungry! Please have at the community house by **10:30 am each day.**
